HOME CARE AND COMMUNITY SERVICES ACT

Amending O. Reg. 386/99

(PROVISION OF COMMUNITY SERVICES)

1. Section 8 of Ontario Regulation 386/99 is amended by adding the following subsection:

(6.1) A local health integration network that provides funding to or on behalf of adults with acquired brain injuries to purchase personal support services is exempt from the provisions of this Regulation with respect to the maximum amount of those services.

2. The Regulation is amended by adding the following section:

APPROVALS UNDER SUBSECTION 28.5 (1) OF THE ACT

- **10.** (1) All homemaking services, personal support services and professional services are prescribed for the purposes of an approval by the Minister, under subsection 28.5 (1) of the Act, for a local health integration network to provide funding to or on behalf of the following persons to purchase a community service:
 - 1. Children with complex medical needs.
 - 2. Adults with acquired brain injuries.
 - 3. Children who are eligible for school health professional services under section 5 of this Regulation or are eligible for school health personal support services under section 7 of this Regulation and who are receiving satisfactory instruction at home in accordance with clause 21 (2) (a) of the *Education Act*.
 - 4. Persons for whom the local health integration network determines that extraordinary circumstances exist that justify the provision of the funding.

(2) The local health integration network shall only provide funding for those services set out in the approval and in accordance with the terms and conditions of the approval.
