Coroners Act 1990, O. Reg. 19/15: Fees, Allowances and Forms

Amendment 1: Remove reference to the Ministry of the Solicitor General's former name – the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services.

Amendment 2: Temporarily increase the fees, on a go forward basis, paid for two attendants to transport a deceased person for further investigation on the authorization of the coroner. The new fee schedule would be in effect until March 31, 2023. A <u>new fee schedule</u> will come into force on April 1, 2023.
