The below list includes <u>minimum</u> weapons and equipment requirement that will be prescribed in regulation for public order units, containment teams, tactical and hostage rescue teams, crisis negotiators, incident commanders, canine units, explosive disposal units, ground and waterways search, and underwater search and recovery.

- Portable voice amplifier
- Every crisis negotiator deployed shall be provided with ballistic protection

Incident Commanders

- Every Incident Commander shall be provided the following:
 - o Computer or tablet with templates, forms, checklists, access to records management systems, and applications to monitor social media
 - Radios with capability for encrypted, dedicated and multi-channel communications along with ear-pieces
 - Mobile device with internet and intranet
 - o Dedicated communication device for the command post or command centre
 - Satellite phone as necessary
 - Mobile command post or command centre as necessary that:
 - Is capable of prolonged housing of minimum of eight persons and be expanded as required to support the operation
 - Has a separate and secure area for negotiation team

Canine Units

Ballistic Protection
 Every member of a canine unit shall be provided with body armour that, at a minimum, meet the following specifications: NIJ Type II as classified by the National Institute of Justice (NIJ) Standard 0106.01 (as amended from time-to-time) Subdued colour or matte finishing "Police" identification markers on front and rear
• If a member of a canine unit is deployed with a unit or team that has a higher level of ballistic protection, they shall be provided with the same level of ballistic protection as that unit or team

 Every member of a canine unit shall be provided with: binoculars with a minimum specification of 10x50 night vision optics firearm mounted lights appropriate weapon sighting system that allows for day or night usage a flashlight with the following specifications:

• Every member of a canine unit shall be provided with a portable radio with capability for encrypted, dedicated and multi-channel communications along with ear-pieces

• Every canine unit shall be provided with a mobile device with internet and intranet access

Canine Vehicle

- Every canine unit shall be provided with a dedicated vehicle that, at a minimum, meets the following specifications:
 - o air conditioning and a heating system
 - Vehicle interior temperature detection and warning system
 - Monitored Intrusion alarm if carrying explosive detection training aids

Police Canine Home Kennel

• Every canine unit shall have a police canine home kennel per canine.

Explosive Disposal Units

Equipment
Every explosive disposal unit shall be provided with a robot that must have remote means of performing reconnaissance and delivery of tools
 Every explosive disposal unit shall be provided with at least one bomb suit that meets the current National Institute of Justice (NIJ) Standard 0117.01 (as amended from time-to-time)
Every explosive disposal unit shall be provided with the following:
 Tools for disruption such as barrelled disruption system and water impulse disruptors
 Hook and line kit
 Category A kit
 At least one portable X-Ray machine
 Range tools including at a minimum, blast lines, galvos and blasting machines, and detonator cans
 Hand tools to support the upkeep and maintenance and operational needs of the EDU.
 Portable lighting systems
Every explosive disposal unit shall have access to a containment vessel
Vehicles

• Every explosive disposal unit shall be provided with a bomb truck that, at a minimum meet the following specifications:

- Must be able to transport all necessary EDU equipment required for calls for service, along with EDU member.
 - Must be able to accommodate 2 Rapid Access Magazines to store detonators and explosives as per Natural Resources Canada standards

Clothing

• Any uniform including footwear and gloves issued to a member of an explosives disposal unit shall have flash protection

Communications

- Every member of an explosive disposal unit shall be provided with a portable radio with capability for encrypted, dedicated and multi-channel communications along with ear-pieces.
- Every explosive disposal unit shall be provided with a mobile device with internet and intranet access

Other Equipment

• Every explosive disposal unit shall be provided with a remotely piloted aircraft system (RPAS)

Explosive Forced Entry

*Members of an Explosive Disposal Unit performing the Explosive Forced Entry function will additionally need the following equipment

- Every member performing explosive forced entry shall be provided with body armour that, at a minimum, meets the following specifications:
 - NIJ Type III as classified by the National Institute of Justice (NIJ) NIJ Standard-0106.01 (as amended from time-to-time)
 - Subdued colour or matte finishing

- Every member performing explosive forced entry shall be provided with helmets that at a minimum meet the following specifications:
 - NIJ Type IIIA as classified by the National Institute of Justice (NIJ) Standard-0106.01 (as amended from time-to-time)
 - Subdued colour or matte finishing

• Every member performing explosive forced entry shall be provided with blast shields designed for explosive entry and hostage rescue.

Ground and Waterways Search

Every member of a police service acting as a searcher shall be provided the following:

- GPS device capable of tracking searchers
- Compass and access to topographical map of the area policed by the police service
- A flashlight with the following specifications:
 - An illumination of a minimum of 60 lumens as measured in an integrated sphere;
 - $\circ~$ Is durable and water-resistant.
- Head lamps
- Backpacks for team equipment
- Radios with capability for encrypted, dedicated and multi-channel communications, along with ear-pieces
- Protective eyewear

Every searcher shall be provided with the following clothing:

- Uniform including footwear, gloves, outerwear and headgear that shall be situationally and environmentally appropriate
- Search and Rescue vest that is highly visible

Every search team shall additionally be provided with a minimum of one night vision optics.

Every search manager shall be provided the following:

- Computer or tablet with search and rescue mapping software able to track the search progress
- Satellite phone as necessary
- A command post with internet connectivity as necessary
- A mobile device with internet and intranet access

Underwater Search and Recovery Units

Every member of a unit responsible for underwater search and recovery shall be provided the following equipment:
