I. O.P.P. Detachments with **NO** O.P.P. Detachment Boards (**Total 2 of 2**)

Detachment	Rationale
Aurora Highway	 Detachment does not police any municipalities. Aurora Highway detachment does provide services to one First Nation (Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation). This First Nation has indicated to the Ministry that they do not have any interest in forming an OPP Detachment Board.
Caledon	 Municipality receives OPP policing services pursuant to an agreement with the Regional Municipality of Peel. Municipality has expressed no interest at this time in forming an OPP Detachment Board but may consider the possibility at a future time, after the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019 (CSPA) in-force date.
