

ELIGIBILITY FOR COMMISSIONS UNDER THE GREAT SEAL (“KING’S COMMISSIONS”)

Title: Eligibility for Commissions Under the Great Seal (“King’s Commissions”) Under the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019

Summary of Proposal:

Under the *Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019* (CSPA), the Lieutenant Governor in Council (LGIC) can issue a Commission under the Great Seal (“King’s Commissions”) to all eligible officers in Ontario.

The ministry is considering making a regulation under the CSPA to prescribe the rank at which police officers and First Nation Officers are eligible to receive a King’s Commission.

The ministry is proposing that O.P.P. officers of the following ranks continue to be eligible to receive King’s Commissions:

- Inspector (or Detective Inspector), Superintendent (or Detective Superintendent), Chief Superintendent, Deputy Commissioner, Commissioner.

The ministry is proposing that other police officers and First Nation Officers of the following ranks are eligible to receive King’s Commissions:

- Inspector (or Detective Inspector), Staff Inspector, Superintendent (or Detective Superintendent), Chief Superintendent or Staff Superintendent, Deputy Chief, Chief of Police.
