Proposed Amendments to Regulation 385/99 (Games of Chance conducted or managed by the Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation) under the *Gaming Control Act, 1992* 

## 1. Exclusion of Individuals from Gaming Premises

- As a result of the transfer of adjudicative responsibilities under the Gaming Control Act, 1992 from the AGCO Board to the Licence Appeal Tribunal the following amendments to Regulation 385/99 are proposed:
  - The AGCO Registrar, rather than the AGCO Board shall give notice to an individual before issuing a direction of exclusion to the OLG to refuse the individual's access to Ontario gaming premises (Subsection 36(1) and (2)).
  - The provision related to hearings, concerning proposed directions of exclusion will be revoked, as the AGCO Board will no longer be holding hearings (Subsection 36 (3)).
  - The Registrar, rather than the AGCO Board, shall issue a direction of exclusion to the OLG requiring it to refuse an individual's access to Ontario gaming premises after considering whatever submissions the individual makes (Subsection 37 (1) and (3)).
  - The Registrar, rather than the AGCO Board, shall revoke such a direction of exclusion if the Registrar is satisfied that the individual has shown cause as to why the direction should be revoked (Subsection 38 (1)).
